Format: 4-board team matches (2 alternates allowed per team), 1 section, 6-round Swiss. All rounds G/75, d/5. Equipment not provided, each team must supply at least two sets and two delay-capable clocks for each round. A side blitz tournament (G/5 d0) will follow the regular league games in October only, separate entry fee applies.

Schedule: 2 rounds per month on Sunday October 6, November 3 and December 8. Doors open 11am, rounds at 11:30am & 2:30pm. No Team Captains meeting, match director will discuss league rules with new team captains individually.

Awards: Trophies to 1st & 2nd place teams, 1st U1700 team*, and top scoring player on each board. (*average of 4 highest rated team members including alternates, based on October ratings.) Possible additional awards, depending on entries.

Entry Fee/Deadline: Advance entries only. Team captains please mail or email name, USCF id, email address and cell phone number of each team member in one submission by Saturday Sept 28th (earlier entries appreciated!). Single players are welcome to inquire and will be placed with a team if possible. Entry fee \$80 per team. Checks payable/mail to Fellowship of the King Chess Club, c/o Neilley & Co. Other: Please plan to patronize Donatos to help meet our food order commitment each day. Due to the acoustics of the room, conversation, young visitors and skittles are not permitted in the basement during play. Games from the October and November matches will be held and submitted for rating along with the December games. This may help players earn "bonus points" when USCF rates the games as one event, will make the games eligible for the USCF Jr. Grand Prix, and will significantly ease submission.
